## **CODE OF ETHICS**

Members or any affiliate of the BPC are expected in the course of performing their duties to:

**SEEK TRUTH AND REPORT IT**. Journalists should be honest, fair and courageous in gathering, reporting and interpreting information.

**MINIMIZE HARM.** Ethical journalists treat sources, subjects and colleagues as human beings deserving of respect.

**ACT INDEPENDENTLY.** Journalists should be free of obligation to any interest other than the public's right to know.

**BE ACCOUNTABLE.** Journalists are accountable to their readers, listeners, viewers and each other.

## Further, members or any affiliate of the BPC should refrain from:

**Engaging** in the practice of self-censorship to suppress essential information.

**Making** headlines, news teasers and promotional material, photos, video, audio, graphics, sound bites and quotations do not misrepresent. They should not oversimplify or highlight incidents out of context.

**Avoid** pandering to lurid curiosity. Show good taste.

**Dressing** and conducting themselves on any assignment in a manner that can bring the profession into disrepute.

## Members of affiliates are further encouraged to:

**Demonstrate** a keen interest in training and research to competently serve the profession and the Bahamian people.
